

CHIROPRACTIC LABS RULES E5A LEVEL 3 (For Students)

- 1. All students will display a professional and responsible attitude towards fellow students, staff and equipment of the Department of Chiropractic.
- 2. Report an incident or accident during class to the Tutor immediately. In addition, an incident/accident report form must be completed and signed by the student and tutor on the same day or as soon as possible. The form and/or notification of the incident should be brought immediately to the attention of the Director Principles and Practice, Aron Downie (aron.downie@mq.edu.au). Forms can be obtained from the university HR website at http://www.ohs.mq.edu.au/form5a.php
- 3. In the case of student concern, confusion, any problem concerning the unit, contact the Unit Convener as soon as possible.
- 4. Ensure that you have completed the "Chiropractic Skills Participation Assessment" (SPA) by week 2 of the semester and that it is recorded at your allotted clinic. A dynamically updated database of your SPA clearance status (or contra-indication status) will be available to technique teaching staff.
- 5. Report to the Tutor immediately all incidents or factors which may influence your ability to participate in classes.
- 6. Do not practise unsupervised. The practice of chiropractic procedures must occur only under the supervision of a qualified tutor. Should you need more opportunities for practice please join the additional weekly Supervised Pracs or the Technique Revision Workshops held during the vacations.
- 7. Equipment cleaning/preparation procedure:
 - a. On entering the lab, students are to wipe down table/pillow/other apparatus with the single-use cleaning wipe from dispensers placed around the lab.
 - b. Place the used wipe in a bin before teaching/demonstration begins.
 - c. Ensure that you cover the chiropractic table with a towel, including a face piece before any use.
 - d. Bring a towel, face cloth and a patient gown (or other suitable garment you're your technique tutorial classes.

- 8. Observe the Tutorial Dress Code for every Technique Tutorial: Shorts (loose pants, not denim) and Patient gown (shirt that opens in back) such that a fellow student will be able to make "skin-on-skin" contact on relevant landmarks from the second sacral tubercle and above as well as the proximal 1/3 thigh and below. Shoes and belts are to be removed and stowed away before using the chiropractic tables.
- 9. Observe the "No Food, Drink or Smoking" rule in the Laboratories and on this floor E5A Level 3.
- 10. Return the Chiropractic tables to their intended location at the end of your class. Seek permission from the Tutor if you need to move a table during class.
- 11. Place all personal items in the cubicles so that the floor, tables and counter tops are clear of debris. This will help avoid slips and trips.
- 12. Restore the Laboratory to a clean and orderly state at the completion of each tutorial. Trash should be thrown way and equipment returned to its original location.
- 13. Do not operate the Audio Visual Equipment; or the monitor volume control, only Tutors are permitted to do so.

Failure to comply with these rules may lead to disciplinary action.
