

#### **ACADEMIC SENATE IN BRIEF**

An update on the key decisions made and matters discussed by Academic Senate on 21 May 2024.

## **DECISIONS OF THE MEETING**

Academic Senate passed 15 resolutions at this meeting. Information on outcomes of specific agenda items may be found in this report or within the minutes.

### Curriculum: Accreditations, Reaccreditations, Amendments and Discontinuations

## **Course Reaccreditations** (Res AS24/33)

Academic Senate approved the full reaccreditation of a suite of undergraduate and postgraduate Law degrees offered by the Faculty of Arts, of a suite of undergraduate and postgraduate Economics and Finance degrees offered by the Macquarie Business School, the Master of Clinical Audiology and the Graduate Certificate of Hearing Sciences offered by the Faculty of Medicine, Health and Human Sciences, and the Bachelor of Science and Bachelor of Science (OUA) offered by the Faculty of Science and Engineering.

# Curriculum Proposals (Res AS24/34)

Academic Senate approved the introduction of four new undergraduate degrees from the Macquarie School of Education in the Faculty of Arts which will replace four existing degrees. Academic Senate also approved a range of curriculum proposals for amendments to courses from the Faculty of Arts, the Macquarie Business School, the Faculty of Medicine, Health and Human Sciences, the Faculty of Science and Engineering and the Macquarie University College.

#### **Other Matters**

- The Deputy Vice-Chancellor (Academic) reported on matters in his portfolio, including the launch of the new Education Strategy (Macquarie Advantage), major appointments within the portfolio, and the Library's new Information and Digital Literacy Framework. He also outlined the impacts of the 2024-2025 Federal budget on the sector, including the formation of the Australian Tertiary Education Commission. - Academic Senate ratified a savings case approved under executive action by the Chair of Academic Senate (Res AS24/43).
