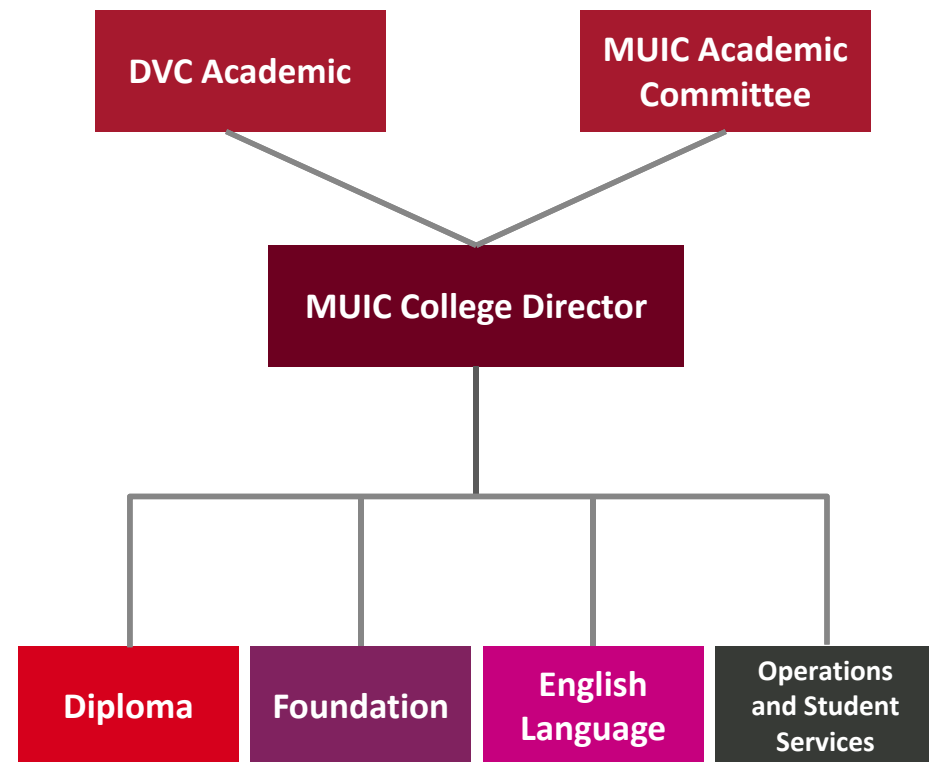


MUIC is an integral part of the academic structure of Macquarie University.

MUIC offers unique 6 teaching week term structure



More time in class + extension activities

Tighter terms, shorter breaks, means less overall time taken to complete program

Programs are taught by Macquarie University teachers/lecturers

Standard Foundation Program & All Diplomas are comprised of 8 units studied over 4 terms. Each term is 7 weeks long. Total program length is 28 weeks

Intensive Foundation Program is comprised of 4 units studied over 2 terms. Each term is 7 weeks long. Total program length is 14 weeks

Students study 2 units per term in an intensive study model where the scope of units studied is less and the focus is more intensively on the 2 unit load.

Unique teaching term structure

Benefits of 4 x 7 teaching week structure

- **Easier for students to focus for an intense period on a smaller number of units (2 units per term).**
- **Shorter breaks between terms means students remain focused and productive, have less downtime.**
- **If extended break needed, for personal or family reasons, easier to take one term off, then return to studies.**
- **Provides for a fast track education, with the standard term programs able to be completed within 7 months.**
- **Compressed term structure, shorter downtime may reduce accommodation costs and living expenses.**

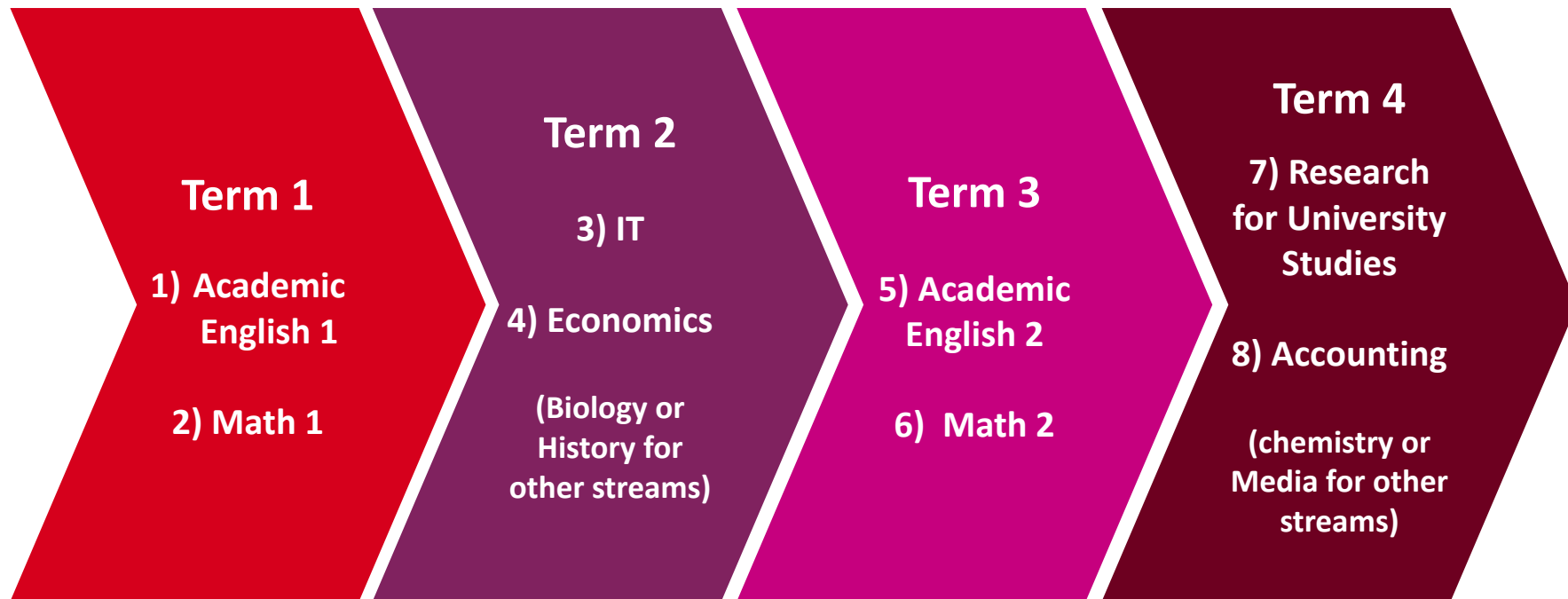

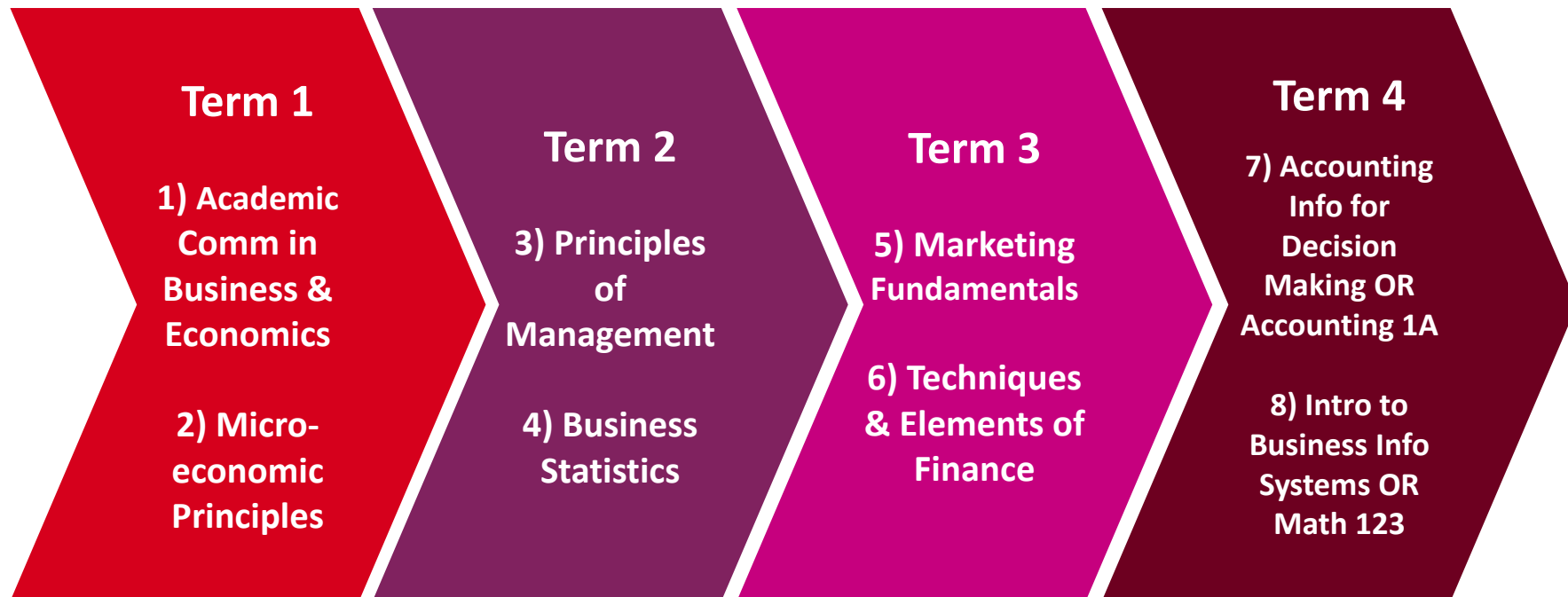
- **Much more scaffolding of English around core units in the Diploma**

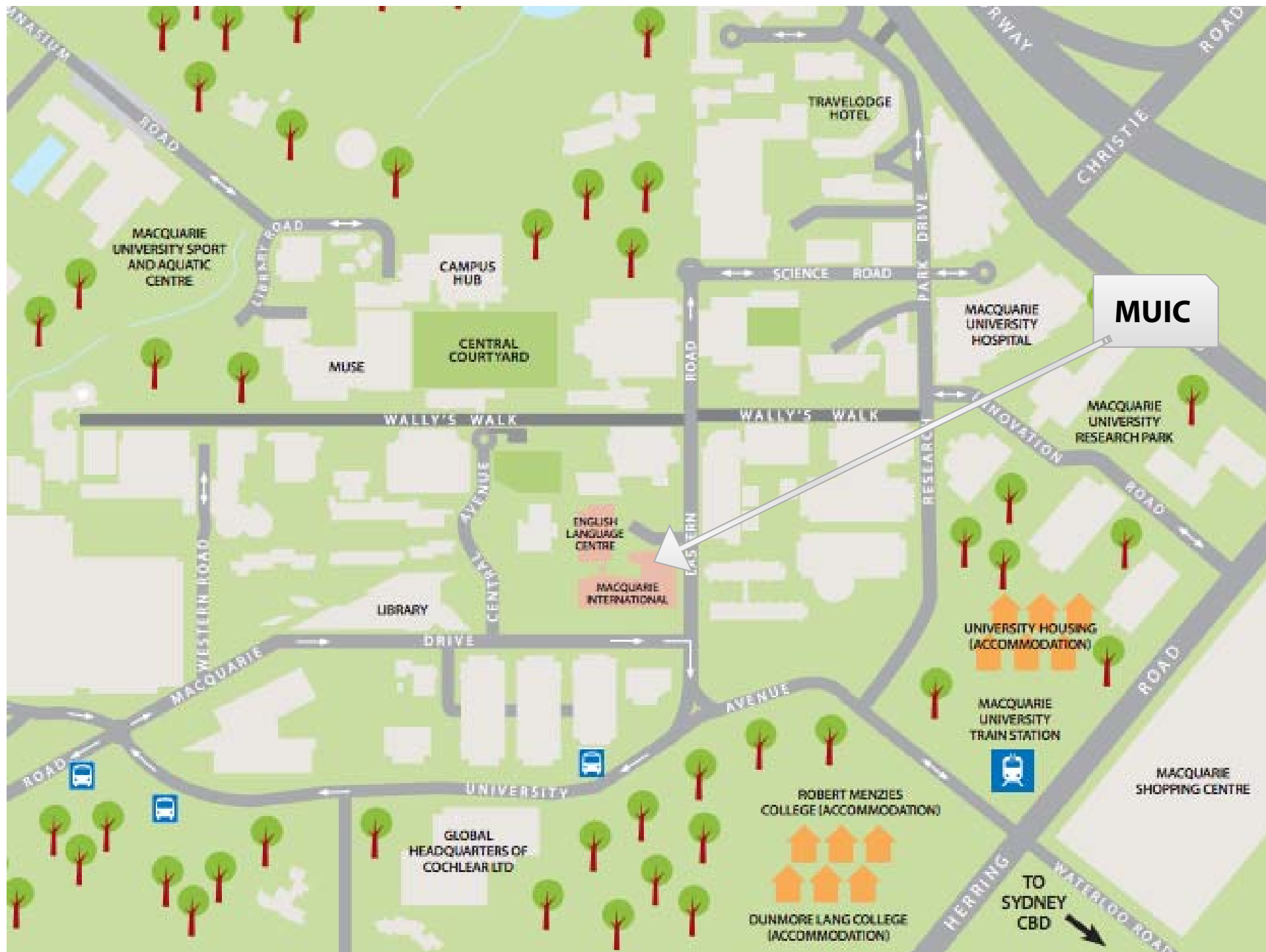


Macquarie's English Language Centre offers a wide range of English Programs to support MUIC students

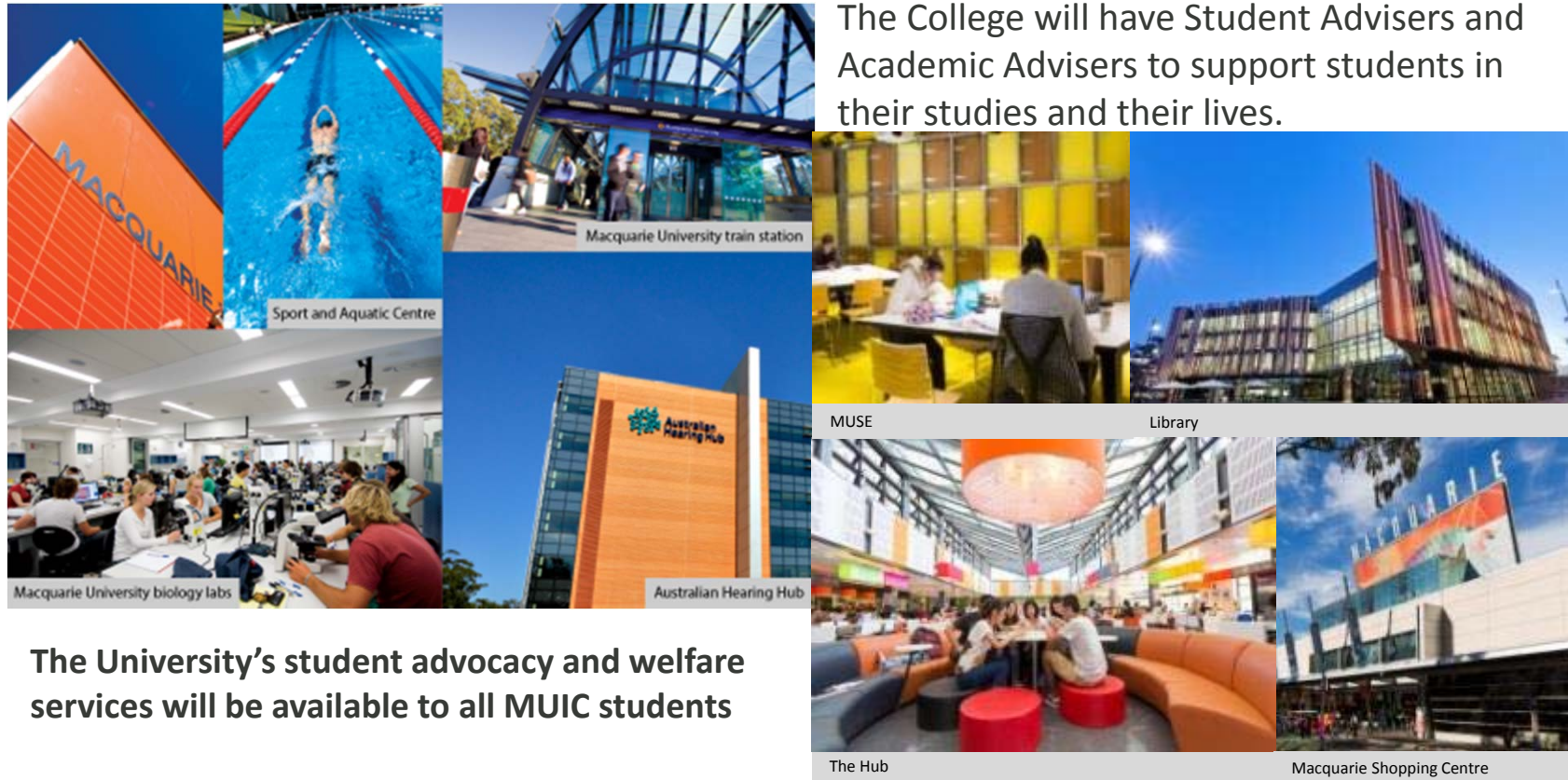

how to apply

MUIC Scholarship – open the door to possibilities

Macquarie University International College Scholarships are awarded to students regardless of country of origin and is an one-off partial amount applied towards a student's tuition fee.

Available to students commencing a Foundation program at MUIC in 2015.

APPLY NOW

- Students will automatically be considered for a MUIC scholarship when they apply for a MUIC Foundation Program commencing in 2015.
- Applications through authorised agents only
- \$3000 per offer for Foundation study commencing in 2015
- 50 places in 2015
- Scholarships are also available in 2016, check with your country manager for details

SIBT to MUIC transition process



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Our foundation and diploma programs are designed and delivered in consultation with senior academics from the University's faculties. This means students can progress seamlessly from pathway studies into their chosen Macquarie University undergraduate degree.

- **Macquarie ended its relationship with SIBT in July 2014.**
- **2015 is the transitioning period before SIBT moves out from Macquarie's North Ryde campus in February 2016.**
- **MUIC will have its first intake for Standard Foundation and Intensive Foundation in November 2015, then first Diploma intake in February 2016.**
- **MUIC is the only preferred pathway by Macquarie University.**

SIBT to MUIC transition process



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University

All current SIBT Diploma students are offered to continue their study at Macquarie's North Ryde campus with the Macquarie University International College.

Students who take up this option will not be disadvantaged with cost or time to complete their current study with MUIC.

Each student who takes up this option will be given individual study plans to ensure their pathway is clear to their degree at MQ.

Special admissions scheme will also be on offer for current SIBT diploma students to transition directly to their future Degree study at MQ upon meeting entry requirements for the scheme.
