A number of **Research Scholarships** are available to undergraduate students during the 2009 summer vacation at the University of York.

The Scholarships are part of an interdisciplinary research programme structured around the broad theme of **Complexity and Computation in Biological and Material Systems** and we invite applications of interest from any students studying a science subject.

All students, including international students, who are committed to a course of study in the following year, are eligible. You will be expected to undertake an 8 to 12 week research project placement under the guidance of an academic supervisor.
